Overall Responsibilities

Enterprise Systems Engineer will develop new software and develop new software modules for existing software with the software development team at the Civil Service Commission.

Scope of Work

- 1. Triage product or system issues and debug/track/resolve by analyzing the sources of issues.
- 2. Participate in continuing education and training to remain current on best practices.
- 3. Take lead on projects, planning, training, and documenting technical specifications as needed.
- 4. Collaborate in a team environment to share best practices, implement process improvements, and ensure software quality.
- 5. Resolve software related issues and provide solutions.
- 6. Deliver well tested and functioning applications developed for the requirements of the product owner.
